State Forest Land Set Apart as a Forest Sanctuary

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 20 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby set apart the area of permanent State forest land described in the Schedule hereto as a forest sanctuary to preserve for scientific purposes an intact example of the original (podocarp-hardwood) forest of Whirinaki Basin.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 10 of the Howard Estate Amendment Act 1927, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Howard Estate Advisory Board Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Howard Estate Advisory Board Regulations* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. **Members' travelling allowance**—Regulation 7 of the principal regulations (as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (1) the expression "\$3.00", and substituting the expression "\$10.00".
