PURSUANT to the Agricultural Pests Destruction Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Union of Tinui and Wairarapa Pest Destruction Districts Order 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Tinui Pest Destruction District and the Wairarapa Pest Destruction District, the boundaries of each of which are specified in the Schedule hereto, are hereby declared united to form one district having the name Wairarapa Pest Destruction District, the boundaries of which shall be an amalgamation

of those specified in the Schedule hereto; and it is hereby further declared that the basis on which the board for the said district shall first levy its general rate shall be the acreage of the land occupied by the ratepayer.
