Revoking Part of a Proclamation Declaring Areas in the Whangarei Acclimatisation District to be Wildlife Refuges (Water Reserves at Whangarei)

ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke that part of the Proclamation issued on the 14th day of February 1958*, declaring the area of land in the Whangarei Acclimatisation District described in the Schedule hereto to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.

SCHEDULE

WATER Reserves at Whangarei—all that area of 1,787 acres 2 roods, more or less, situated in Blocks XI and XII, Purua Survey District, being Allotment 38, Parish of Kaitara, Allotment 8, Parish of Pukenui, and Allotments 54 and 76 and the north-western portion of Allotment 55, Parish of Whangarei.

As the same is shown on plan marked I.A. 52/353, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
