*Defining the Limits of the Waverley Harbour Pilotage District*

ALL the waters of the Tasman Sea bounded by the line of mean high-water spring tides and having as its seaward limit the arc of a circle of 3 nautical miles radius centred at 39° 49.63' S, 174° 36.56' E near the mouth of the Wairoa Stream.
