In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 23 and 35 of the Counties Act 1956, the Thames County Council resolves by way of special order as follows:

- 1. The present division of the County of Thames into three ridings is revoked and in lieu thereof the said County shall be divided into four ridings to be called respectively Hastings Riding, Puriri Riding, Tairua Riding, and Whangamata Riding, which said ridings are respectively described in the Schedule
- 2. The said Thames County Council shall consist of nine members who shall be elected as follows:
 - (a) The electors of the Hastings Riding, the Puriri Riding and the Whangamata Riding shall each elect two
 - (b) The electors of the Tairua Riding shall elect three Councillors.
