NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

McLeod's Bay - Taurikura Water Supply Loan 1971, \$101,000
PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Whangarei County Council hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$101,000, authorised to be raised by the Whangarei County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of providing a public water supply for the McLeod's Bay - Taurikura District the said Whangarei County Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.05 cents in the dollar (\$) upon the rateable value on the basis of the unimproved value of all rateable property in the County of Whangarei; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, and be payable half yearly on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
