The Stokes Valley Licensing Trust Constitution Notice 1970

PURSUANT to the Local Licensing Trusts Regulations*, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Stokes Valley Licensing Trust Constitution Notice 1970.

2. There is hereby constituted a local licensing trust, to be called the Stokes Valley Licensing Trust.

3. (1) The first election of members of the Trust shall be held on Saturday, the 6th day of March 1971.

(2) The Returning Officer for the first election of members of the Trust shall be Kenneth Alexander Hamilton, City Treasurer for the City of Lower Hutt.

4. The area within which polls shall be taken for elections of members of the Trust shall be the whole of the area described in the Schedule to this notice.

5. The area within which the Trust shall distribute its profits shall be the whole of the area described in the Schedule to this notice.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District comprising portion of the City of Lower Hutt bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the western boundary of Section 742, Hutt District, with the eastern side of Eastern Hutt Road in Block IV, Belmont S.D., and proceeding southerly and generally easterly along the western and generally southern boundaries of the said Section 742 to its easternmost corner; thence generally southerly along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 27329, the north-eastern and southern boundaries of Section 248, Hutt District, and the eastern boundaries of Sections 234 and 233, Hutt District, to
