NOTICE OF PRIVATE BILL

IN the matter of a Private Bill intitled "An Act to Consolidate and Amend the Bank of New Zealand Officers' Provident Association Act 1900 and its Amendment" notice is hereby given that the Bank of New Zealand Officers' Provident Association, a body corporate constituted by the Bank of New Zealand Officers' Guarantee and Provident Association (hereinafter referred to as "the said Association"), intends to apply to the House of Representatives in Parliament assembled for leave to bring in the above-mentioned Bill of short title of which is the Bank of New Zealand Officers' Provident Association Act 1971.

The objects of the Bill are to consolidate and amend the Bank of New Zealand Officers' Provident Association Act 1900 and its amendments, and in connection therewith and incidental thereto, to extend the powers of the association in relation to the borrowing and investment of moneys, and the undertaking of, or participation in, joint ventures and other appropriate financial and fiduciary activities or arrangements and any securities connected therewith, for the purpose of enabling the association to utilise its funds to better advantage, having regard to modern commercial conditions, for the benefit of its members and their dependants.
