- 5. This consent confers no rights to water under the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967, or otherwise.
- 6. For the purpose of assessing the rental or annual sum payable in respect of this consent, the maximum generating capacity of the plant at the date of this consent is 11 kW.

REVOCATION

This consent is issued in place of a licence issued to William Gray Henderson, of Lake Brunner, by an Order in Council dated the 7th day of February 1967, and appearing in the Gazette on the 16th day of February 1967, at page 219, which licence is consequentially revoked.
