A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a further portion of the Dunedin-Milton Motorway shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the lands situated within the limits of the area shown coloured red, on the plan marked M.O.W. 24805 (S.O. 12977b) referred to in the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE

OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

COMMENCING at a point on the south-western boundary of Lot 30, Deeds Plan 164, 1 chain from the north-western corner of that lot, proceeding thence in an easterly direction generally for a distance of 88 chains approximately, passing in, into, through, or over the following roads, streets, ways, highways, or lands, etc., viz: part Lots 30, 28, 26, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 10, and 11, Deeds Plan 164 (Proclamation No. 332831); part Lot 1, D.P. 9112 (Proclamation No. 332831); part Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 7052 (Proclamation No. 332831); part Sections 23, 24, and 86, Irregular Block, East Taieri Survey District (Proclamation No. 332831); Quarry Road and unnamed road taken by Proclamation No. 5423; part Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 5910 (C.T. 318/93); part Section 25, Irregular Block, East Taieri Survey District (C.T.
