

*Privileges and Immunities of Representatives and Their Staffs Attending the South Pacific Forum*

WHEREAS the South Pacific Forum is being held in Wellington in August 1971:

And whereas the said forum is being attended by representatives of the Government of New Zealand and by representatives of the Governments of Australia, the Cook Islands, Fiji, Nauru, Tonga, and Western Samoa:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 11 of the Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act 1968, the Minister of Foreign Affairs hereby directs that—

- (a) Every representative of the said Governments (other than the Government of New Zealand) shall be accorded the privileges and immunities conferred by or by virtue of Part I of the Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act 1968 on a diplomatic agent; and
- (b) All the members of the official staff of any such representative shall be accorded the privileges and immunities conferred by or by virtue of Part I of the Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act 1968 on members of the diplomatic staff of a diplomatic mission.
