A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 17th day of October 1969, and published in *Gazette*, 30 October 1969, Volume III, page 2152, taking land for soil conservation and river control purposes in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.
