Decisions Under the Sales Tax Act 1932-33, Notice No. 58

DECISIONS in interpretation of the Sales Tax Act notified in the Supplement to the *New Zealand Gazette* of 30 April 1970, No. 25, are amended as follows:

Minister's Decision 6 is amended by the addition of the following:

- (10) The enveloping, addressing, stamping and/or mailing of printed matter. Tax is, however, payable on any taxable materials used.
