THAT in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 and amendments, and the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and amendments, and regulations thereunder, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, the North Canterbury Catchment Board resolves:

"That, for the purpose of providing interest, principal, and other charges on a loan of \$50,000, to be known as the Office Building Loan 1970, authorised to be raised by the North Canterbury Catchment Board under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of building office accommodation, the said North Canterbury Catchment Board hereby makes a special rate of 0.001535c in the dollar on the adjusted rateable special rate of 0.001335 in the dollar on the adjusted rateable value (on the basis of capital value) on all rateable properties comprised within the boundaries of the North Canterbury Catchment Board area, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of up to 10 years or until the loan is fully paid off."

It is not proposed to collect the special rate as the loan charges will be met out of the rental of the cottages.
