Hauraki Plains College Board of Governors Notice 1971

PURSUANT to section 51 of the Education Act 1964, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Hauraki Plains College Board of Governors Notice 1971.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1972.

2. The Board of Governors of Hauraki Plains College shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the South Auckland Education Board;
- (b) One member elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Kaihere School District or the Mangatarata School District;
- (c) Two members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Kerepehi School District;
- (d) One member being elected by the parents of pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Maramarua School District;
- (e) Two members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Ngatea School District;
- (f) One member elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Turua School District or the Kopuarahi School District;
- (g) One member elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Kaiaua School District and the Waitakaruru School District;
- (h) One member appointed by the Hauraki Plains County Council; and
- (i) One member co-opted by the Board of Governors itself and when it thinks fit.

(f) One member appointed by the Hutt County Council.
