ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, County of Waipara, containing 73,875 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the mean high-water mark of the sea in the middle of the Waipara River, in Block X, Teviotdale Survey District, and proceeding north-westerly generally up the middle of the Waipara River to the middle of No. 1 State Highway, Awanui-Bluff, in Block I, Teviotdale Survey District; thence north-easterly generally along the middle of that highway and Glenmark Road to the south-western boundary of Section 5, Glenmark Settlement; thence north-westerly along that boundary and the south-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 4716, to the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 9958; thence northerly generally along that boundary and the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 4046, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of Waikari Valley Road; thence easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 2256, in Block XI, Waikari Survey District; thence southerly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of the South Island Main Trunk Railway; thence southerly generally along the middle of that railway to the middle of the No. 1 State Highway, Awanui-Bluff, in Block XIV, Waikari Survey District; thence north-easterly, south-easterly, and south-westerly generally along the middle of that highway, the middle of Motunau Beach Road, and the middle of the road fronting the south-eastern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 24869, to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 12959 in Block X, Stonyhurst Survey District; thence southerly to and along that boundary and south-westerly and south-easterly along the north-western and south-western boundaries of that lot and the south-western boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 17614, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of Cotswold Road; thence south-westerly along the middle of that road for a distance of about 10 chains to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 24987; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary to the westernmost corner of that lot; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of that lot, Lot 7, D.P. 17614, and Lot 2, D.P. 13843, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of Vulcan Road; thence easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 12025; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 8423; thence south-westerly along that boundary and south-easterly along the south-western boundary of Rural Section 30982 and the production of that boundary to the mean high-water mark of the sea; thence south-westerly generally along that mean high-water mark to the point of commencement.

BOUNDARIES OF MOTUNAU WARD

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, Counties of Waipara and Cheviot, containing 57,875 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the mean high-water mark of the sea in the middle of the Hurunui River, in Block I, Weld Survey District, and proceeding south-westerly generally along the mean high-water mark of the sea to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Rural Section 30982, in Block XVI, Stonyhurst Survey District; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and north-easterly along the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 8423, to the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 12025; thence northerly along that boundary and its production to the middle of Vulcan Road; thence westerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 13843; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and the south-western boundaries of Lot 7, D.P. 17614, and Lot 2, D.P. 24987, and north-easterly along the north-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 24987, and its production to a point on the middle of Cotswold Road approximately 10 chains from the production of the south-western boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 17614; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the said south-western boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 17614; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and the south-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 12959, and north-easterly and northerly along the north-western and western boundaries of that lot and the

production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the road fronting the south-eastern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 24869; thence westerly along the middle of that road, and north-westerly generally along the middle of Motunau Beach Road to the middle of No. 1 State Highway, Awanui-Bluff; thence north-easterly generally along the middle of that highway to the middle of the Hurunui River; thence easterly down the middle of that river to the point of commencement. Save and except from the above-described area, Lot 1, D.P. 4244, being Rural Section 10585, the part Lot 3, D.P. 24296, being Rural Section 9886, and the part Lot 1, D.P. 17745, being Rural Section 9888, in Block X, Stonyhurst Survey District.

BOUNDARIES OF WEKA WARD

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, County of Waipara, containing 63,950 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the middle lines of Birchdale Road and Murrays Road, in Block II, Waipara Survey District, and proceeding south-easterly along the middle of Birchdale Road, Allandale Road, Horsley Down Road, and Princes Street to the middle of No. 7 State Highway; thence southerly along the middle of that highway to a point in line with the middle of Waikari Valley Road; thence easterly generally to and along the middle of Waikari Valley Road, Sealeys Direct Road, and Waikari Valley Road again to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 4046, in Block IX, Waikari Survey District; thence southerly generally to and along that boundary and the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 9958, to the south-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 4716; thence south-easterly along that boundary and the south-western boundary of Section 5, Glenmark Settlement, to the middle of Glenmark Road; thence south-westerly generally along the middle of that road and No. 1 State Highway, Awanui-Bluff, to the middle of the Waipara River; thence westerly generally up the middle of that river to its confluence with the north branch of the Waipara River; thence northerly generally up the middle of that river to the middle of Heathstock Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road and Pawseys Road to the intersection of Birchdale Road and Murrays Road, to the point of commencement.
