RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

City Development Redemption Loan 1971, \$101,400

THAT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments, and all other powers in that behalf thereunto enabling it, the Palmerston North City Council doth hereby resolve as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of one hundred and one thousand four hundred dollars (\$101,400) authorised to be raised by the Palmerston North City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying on maturity that portion of the City Development Loan 1961, \$284,000, first issue of \$164,000, which matures on 1 December 1971, the said Palmerston North City Council hereby makes a special rate of two hundred and forty-three ten-thousandths of a cent (0.0243c) in the dollar (\$) upon the rateable value (upon the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the City of Palmerston North and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of the loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

Parking Land Purchase and Development Loan 1969, \$100,000

THAT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments, and all other powers in that behalf enabling it, the Palmerston North City Council doth hereby resolve as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) authorised to be raised by the Palmerston North City Council, under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing land to provide vehicle parking, the Palmerston North City Council hereby makes a special rate of one hundred and fifty-one ten-thousandths of a cent (0.0151c) in the dollar (\$) upon the rateable value (upon the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the City of Palmerston North and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
