Hoe-o-Tainui Hall Loan 1971, \$3,500

Fairton Township Water Supply Loan 1971, \$4,000

THAT, pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Ashburton County Council hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of four thousand dollars (\$4,000), authorised to be raised by the Ashburton County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of providing a water supply for Fairton township, the said Ashburton County Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.964 of one cent in the dollar (\$) upon the rateable value on the basis of the capital value of all rateable property in the Fairton water supply special rating area comprising all that part of the Wakanui Riding of the County of Ashburton, which is bounded as follows:

Commencing at a point on the centre line of Fairfield Road opposite the north-west boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 1482, thence north-eastwards along the north-west boundary of Lots 1-18, D.P. 1482, thence south-east along the north-east boundary of Lot 18, D.P. 1482, produced to the centre line of Fairfield Avenue thence south-west along the centre line of Fairfield Avenue, to and thence south-east along the centre line of Deans Street to the line of the south-east boundary of Lots 80 and 79, D.P. 1482, and thence south-west along the said boundary.
