PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation issued on the 18th day of July 1960*, declaring an area of land in the Hukatere Survey District, and in the Hobson Acclimatisation District, to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.
