PURSUANT to section 54 of the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Tokomairiro High School Board of Governors Order 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1971.

2. There shall be a Board of Governors for the Tokomairiro High School which shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the Otago Education Board;
- (b) Five members elected by the parents of pupils attending the school;
- (c) Two members elected by the members of the school committees of Lovell's Flat, Milburn, Milton, and Tokoiti primary schools;
- (d) One member appointed by the Bruce County Council and the Milton Borough Council;
- (e) Two members co-opted by the Board of Governors itself if and when it thinks fit.

3. The Otago Education Board shall cease to control the Tokomairiro High School and the sole control of that school shall be vested in the Board of Governors constituted by clause 2 of this order.
