

## MOUNT ALBERT BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE AS SECURITY FOR THE MOUNT ALBERT ROADING REDEMPTION LOAN 1971, \$20,500, PASSED BY THE MOUNT ALBERT BOROUGH COUNCIL AT A MEETING HELD ON 9 NOVEMBER 1971

THAT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of \$20,500, known as the Roothing Redemption Loan 1971, \$20,500, for the purpose of repaying on maturity that portion of the Roothing Loan 1960, \$200,000, which matures on 27 November 1971, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought nought three nine of a cent (.0039c) in the dollar on the rateable value on the basis of the capital value of all rateable property in the Borough of Mount Albert, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
