## SPECIAL ORDERS

THE Auckland Regional Authority in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, section 42, and in pursuance of the authority conferred upon it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it on that behalf, doth hereby resolve by special resolution intended to operate as a special order to borrow the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) as a special loan to be known as Bulk Water Supply Loan No. 18, 1968, \$2,000,000—Third Issue \$1,000,000, for the purposes of an incidental to the upgrading of the northern and western transmission mains of the bulk water supply system.

The foregoing special order was passed at a special meeting of the Auckland Regional Authority convened for that purpose and held on 20 September 1971 and confirmed at an ordinary meeting of the said Authority held on 15 November 1971, having meantime been advertised in the *Auckland Star* on 23 October and 13 November 1971.
