Kaikoura High School Board of Governors Notice 1972

PURSUANT to section 54 of the Education Act 1964, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Kaikoura High School Board of Governors Notice 1972.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1972.

2. There shall be a Board of Governors for Kaikoura High School which shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the Canterbury Education Board;
- (b) Seven members elected by parents of pupils attending the school;
- (c) One member appointed by the Kaikoura County Council;
- (d) One member elected by the members of the School Committee of Kaikoura Primary School;
- (e) One member elected by the School Committees of Hapuku, Kaikoura Suburban, Lynton Downs, and Oaro Primary Schools.

3. The Canterbury Education Board shall cease to control Kaikoura High School and the sole control of that school shall be vested in the Board of Governors constituted by clause 2 of this notice.

Validating Proceedings in Connection With the Bay of Islands County Council's Loan of \$20,000

WHEREAS the Bay of Islands County Council has commenced proceedings for raising a loan of \$20,000 to be known as the "Paihia Fire Brigade Loan 1971":

And whereas the said Council has prepared a special roll in respect of the part of its district which is to receive the benefit of the said loan:

And whereas the said proceedings are irregular or defective in that, contrary to regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Loans Regulations 1957, the said Council made application to the Local Authorities Loans Board for sanction to the said loan before the said special roll had been authenticated:

And whereas it appears that the ratepayers have not been misled by such irregularity or defect and it is expedient to validate the same:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 130 of the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 (as amended by section 15 of the Local Authorities Loans Amendment Act 1971), the Minister of Finance hereby declares that the proceedings in connection with the raising of the said loan shall be valid to all intents and purposes as though the said application had not been made until the said special roll had been authenticated.
