Rural Housing Loan 1971—\$100,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Otorohanga County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$100,000, authorised to be raised by the Otorohanga County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of making advances to farmers in terms of the Rural Housing Act 1939, the said Otorohanga County Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.04386c in the dollar upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Otorohanga; and that the special rate be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 35 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
