

ORDER

1. (a) This order may be cited as the Taharoa Domain Board Order 1972.

(b) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this order—

“The Act” means the Harbours Act 1950;

“The Board” means the Taharoa Domain Board;

“Minister” means the Minister of Marine and Fisheries; and includes any officers, person, or authority acting by or under the direction or authority of the Minister.

3. There is hereby granted to the Board, for a period of 21 years from the commencement of this order, subject to the provisions of section 8A of the Act and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this order, the control of the waters described in the First Schedule to this order.

FIRST SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF WATERS

ALL the waters of Lake Taharoa, Lake Waikere, and Lake Kaiwi in Hobson County.

SECOND SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the provisions of section 8A of the Act, the Board for and within the area of waters described in the First Schedule to this order—

(a) May, by bylaw, do anything which a Harbour Board may do, by bylaw, under section 232 of the Act;

(b) May appoint harbourmasters and/or officers, and define or limit their powers or duties; and

(c) Shall administer such regulations made pursuant to the Act as are applicable.

2. The said rights, powers, and privileges may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General, without payment of any compensation whatever, on giving to the Council 6 calendar months' notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at, or posted to, the last known address of the Council in New Zealand.
