

*Declaring Land in the Otago Land District to be Crown Land

Setting Apart Land as a Maori Reservation

WHEREAS by notice dated 25 May 1971 and published in the *Gazette*, 27 May 1971, No. 38, p. 996, the land described in the First Schedule hereto was set apart as a Maori reservation; and whereas it is now desired to make amendments to the said notice now, therefore, pursuant to section 439 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, notice is hereby given as follows.
