Temporary Protection of Industry

NOTICE is hereby given that the Emergency Protection Authority has been requested to undertake an inquiry in terms of the Tariff and Development Board Act 1961 and its amendments, and to report in terms of section 10b of that Act, concerning the following goods:

- 1. Union fabrics composed of wool and cotton, the current domestic value of which does not exceed that specified by the Minister, to be cut up and made into shirts, pyjamas, nightgowns, or underclothing, under such conditions as the Minister may prescribe falling within Tariff Item 53.11.009.
- 2. Union fabrics composed of cotton and wool, the current domestic value of which does not exceed that specified by the Minister, to be cut up and made into shirts, pyjamas, nightgowns, or underclothing, under such conditions as the Minister may prescribe falling within Tariff Item 55.09.101.
- 3. Union textiles composed of wool and man-made fibres and/or cotton, the current domestic value of which, expressed in New Zealand currency, does not exceed \$1.12 per yd², to be cut up and made into shirts, pyjamas, nightgowns, or underclothing, under such conditions as the Minister may prescribe falling within Section XI and covered by a general reference in part II of the Tariff.
