Setting Apart Land as a Maori Reservation

WHEREAS by Order in Council dated 22 April 1964 and published in *Gazette*, 30 April 1964, No. 26, p. 739, the land described in the First Schedule hereto was set apart as a Maori reservation, and whereas it is now desired to extend the reservation to contain adjoining land as recommended by the Maori Land Court and also to show the new appellation of the reserve, now therefore, pursuant to section 439 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, notice is hereby given as follows.
