Warrant Appointing Committee of Inquiry Pursuant to Industrial Relations Act 1949

I, David Thomson, Minister of Labour, being of the opinion that an industrial dispute exists between

The Wellington Fire Brigade Officers' (other than Chief Fire Officer and Deputy Chief Fire Officer) Industrial Union of Workers;

The Wellington City Fire Brigadesmen's (other than Officers) Industrial Union of Workers; and
The Wellington Fire Board;

which is threatening to cause a partial or total discontinuance of employment, and that normal means of reaching a settlement of the dispute have failed to do so, consider it desirable in the public interest to appoint a Committee of Inquiry pursuant to section 8A of the Industrial Relations Act 1949; and the parties concerned in the dispute having agreed that the said Committee of Inquiry may consist of one person I hereby appoint

- (e) The provision of fire heating and lighting in officers' quarters;

and to report the results and findings of the inquiry to me and make recommendations for the settlement of these matters.
