Tariff and Development Board Notice No. 284—Inquiry Concerning Protection for the New Zealand Industry Producing Copper Tubing— Public Hearing

- 1. Following receipt by the Minister of Customs of a report from the Emergency Protection Authority the Government has accepted the recommendations of the Authority that a separate item code be created in the Import Licensing Schedule for seamless tubes and pipes and blanks therefor, of unalloyed copper, of sizes not exceeding 3 inches in external diameter, with an allocation of "C" and with basic licences 50% of imports under 1971 licences.
- 2. In accordance with the Tariff and Development Board Act the Minister of Customs has requested the Board to inquire into and report on the nature and degree of protection, if any, it considers necessary to protect the New Zealand industry producing copper tubing classified in the Customs Tariff as follows:
