NOTICE OF PRIVATE BILL

AN ACT TO AMEND THE EAST COAST PERMANENT TRUSTEES LTD. ACT 1962

NOTICE is hereby given that East Coast Permanent Trustees Ltd. (hereinafter called "the Company") intends to apply for leave to bring into the House of Representatives, during the present session of Parliament, a Private Bill, the short title of which is the East Coast Permanent Trustees Ltd. Amendment Act 1972.

The object of the proposed Bill is to amend the East Coast Permanent Trustees Ltd. Act 1962 (hereinafter called "the principal Act") to provide that, in the event of the Company being wound up, the liability imposed on the then present and past members of the Company by subsection (1) of section 20 of the principal Act (as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) to contribute to the

assets of the Company, shall be the same as the liability which would have been imposed by the said subsection (1) if each of the existing shares of 1 pound each in the capital of the Company on the 31st day of December 1965 had not been subdivided on that date into two shares of 10 shillings each.
