*The Traffic (Te Awamutu Borough) Notice No. 1, 1972*

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Te Awamutu Borough) Notice No. 1, 1972.

2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby excluded from the limitation as to speed imposed by section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 40-miles-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*.

4. The road specified in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a limited speed zone for the purposes of regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*.

5. The Traffic (Te Awamutu Borough) Notice 1968, dated the 29th day of February 1968†, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*, which relates to roads in Te Awamutu Borough, is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within the Te Awamutu Borough:

No. 3 State Highway (Hamilton-Woodville via New Plymouth) (from the northern boundary of Te Awamutu Borough to a point 2 chains measured northerly generally along the said State Highway from Christie Avenue).

Cambridge Road (from the eastern boundary of Te Awamutu Borough to a point 45 chains measured westerly generally along the said road from the said boundary).

Te Rahu Road (from the north-eastern boundary of Te Awamutu Borough to a point 4 chains measured north-easterly generally along the said road from Picquet Hill Road).

SECOND SCHEDULE

SITUATED within the Te Awamutu and Waipa County adjacent thereto:

No. 3 State Highway (Hamilton-Woodville via New Plymouth) (from a point 2 chains measured northerly generally along the said State highway from Christie Avenue to the northern boundary of Te Awamutu Borough).
