The Motor Launch (Mataura River) Notice 1971—Southland County Council

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Motor Launch (Mataura River) Notice 1971.

(b) This notice shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*, and shall remain in force until further notice.

2. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, regulations 11 and 12 of the Motor Launch Regulations 1962 shall not apply with respect to the area described in the First Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area of water 300 yd long and 100 yd wide, 3 miles down stream from Gore at Beattie's Beach on the Mataura River.

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. At the river's edge on both sides of the river at each end of the above-described area there shall be placed notice boards measuring not less than 2 ft 6 in. by 2 ft, painted bright orange with black lettering in the following form:

"NOTICE

MOTOR LAUNCH REGULATIONS 1962

No speed restriction for motor launches and water skiers between these notice boards."
