A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of

Internal Affairs and the Minister of Lands (being the Minister charged with the administration of the department of State having the control of the land of the Crown affected by this Proclamation), hereby revoke the Proclamation issued on the 3rd day of April 1958* declaring an area of land in the Orahiri and Otanake Survey Districts and in the Auckland Acclimatisation District to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.
