Approval of Revolving Amber Light for RNZAF Police Vehicles

PURSUANT to regulation 39 of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, the Secretary for Transport hereby approves the fitting of one revolving amber light on any RNZAF police motor vehicle, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The vehicle shall be painted a conspicuous colour and shall be readily identifiable as an RNZAF police vehicle.
- 2. The light is used only when the vehicle is stationary at the scene of an accident, until such time as suitable and adequate warning signs or barriers can be erected.
