# ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General By his Deputy ALEXANDER TURNER A PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to section 20 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby set apart the area of State Forest Park described in the Schedule hereto as a forest sanctuary to preserve representative examples of the Coromandel kauri forests.
