ORDER

THE Auckland Metropolitan Fire Board Election Order 1969, published in the *Gazette*, 1969, Vol. III, p. 2203, is hereby amended by revoking subclause (5) of clause 6, and substituting the following subclause:

"(5) Within 14 days of the receipt of the list each Mayor or, as the case may be, Chairman of a local authority shall cause a meeting of his council to be held for the purpose of allocating the prescribed number of votes to which that local authority is entitled in respect of the candidates on the list. At the meeting the local authority shall, by resolution, allocate its prescribed number of votes in respect of each of 2 of the candidates where 2 candidates are required to be elected or in respect of 1 of the candidates where only 1 is required."
