A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I, the Right Honourable Sir Herbert Richard Churton Wild, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby amend the Proclamation dated the 1st day of July 1971, published in *Gazette*, 29 July 1971, No. 56, p. 1481, and registered as Proclamation No. 374191, Otago Land Registry (hereinafter called "the former Proclamation"), defining the middle line of a further portion of the Dunedin-Milton

Motorway in Irregular Block, East Taieri Survey District, and Blocks VII and VIII, Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, so that the former Proclamation shall affect not only the land situated within the limits of the area shown coloured red on the plan marked M.O.W. 24805 (S.O. 12977B) referred to in the former Proclamation, but also the land described in the Schedule hereto.
