## Traffic Regulations—RNZAF Police Vehicles Exempted from Interior Door Handles

PURSUANT to regulation 25A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*, the Secretary for Transport hereby exempts police vehicles operated by the RNZAF from the requirements of subclause 2 of regulation 50 of the said regulations in so far as it relates to the fitting of a door handle for opening the door of the rear compartment from inside, provided that whenever apprehended personnel are being transported they are accompanied by a member of the RNZAF police who carries a device capable of opening the door from inside the compartment.
