Licensing the Waikato Power Boat Club (Inc.) to Occupy a Site for a Slipway on the Waikato River, Hamilton

PURSUANT to section 162 of the Harbours Act 1950, I, Peter Edward Muers, of the Ministry of Transport, in exercise of powers delegated by the Minister of Transport, hereby license and permit the Waikato Power Boat Club (Inc.) (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the bed of the Waikato River, Hamilton, as shown on plan marked M.D. 13084 and deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining thereon a ramp and breakwater as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

CONDITIONS

(1) This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1960 and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

(2) The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of February 1973.

(3) The premium payable by the licensee shall be six dollars (\$6) and the annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be six dollars (\$6); provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.
