6. Livestock in Crates—Calves (not exceeding six months old), sheep, pigs or goats properly secured in crates so as to prevent damage to other goods will be charged as follows:

Gross Weight per Crate Class C plus 50%. Not exceeding 153 kg ... Exceeding 153 kg Class C double rate.

7. Where the owner desires that livestock in crates be forwarded in a livestock wagon, the railage charges on the consignment must not be less than the appropriate charges for such livestock had the same been forwarded loose in the wagon.

8. Store Cattle and Store Sheep in Large Mobs-Cattle and sheep from one consignor and forwarding station to one consignee and destination station, certified by the consignor to be bona fide store stock, not consigned for slaughter, will be charged as follows:
