6. Livestock in Crates—Calves (not exceeding six months old), sheep, pigs or goats properly secured in crates so as to prevent damage to other goods will be charged as follows:

Gross Weight per Crate	Rate
Not exceeding 153 kg	Class C plus 50%.
Exceeding 153 kg	Class C double rate.

7. Where the owner desires that livestock in crates be forwarded in a livestock wagon, the railage charges on the consignment must not be less than the appropriate charges for such livestock had the same been forwarded loose in the wagon.

8. Store Cattle and Store Sheep in Large Mobs—Cattle and sheep from one consignor and forwarding station to one consignee and destination station, certified by the consignor to be bona fide store stock, not consigned for slaughter, will be charged as follows:

162 km and over ..	{ First 15 wagons .. Class M.

Under 162 km ..	As for 162 km at the above rates if cheaper than the classified rates.

9. Fodder—Consignors of stock may be allowed free conveyance of fodder sufficient for the outward journey, and in the case of show stock for homeward journey also.

2. Minimum Charge—Except where otherwise provided, any less quantity than the minimum prescribed will be charged at such minimum, or on actual weight at the following rates, whichever is cheaper:
