NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

NOTICE is hereby given that the Te Kuiti Borough Council proposes, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, to execute certain public works, namely, the erection and establishment of a sewerage treatment station and oxidation ponds on the lands described in the Schedule hereto, and for the purpose of such public works the said lands are and will require to be taken by the said Corporation, under the provisions of the above Acts, and notice is further given that a full and legal description of the lands so required is deposited in the offices of Low, Chapman, and Carter, Solicitors, King Street, Te Kuiti, and is open for inspection without fee during the office hours.
