Grey duck, 15.
Shoveler (or spoonbill), 15.
Mallard duck, 15.
Paradise duck, 6.
Grey, shoveler (or spoonbill), mallard, and paradise duck, 15 in all.
Shooting hours: 6.15 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.
Decoy limit: 10.

Special Conditions

Persons holding valid game shooting licences for the Waimarino Acclimatisation District may, without taking out a further game licence, shoot in the following areas that lie within the Rotorua Acclimatisation District:

- (a) On the waters or from the banks of those portions of the Wanganui River and its tributaries;
- (b) On the Otamangakau Lake and its watershed including the Wairehu Canal upstream of the fish screens.

The conditions prescribed in the notification in respect of the Rotorua Acclimatisation District shall apply to these areas.

(except that the season will end on 17 June in the north-eastern part of the Wanganui Acclimatisation District from a point at the junction of the middle of the Mangawhero River with the Rangitatau Stream, thence up the Rangitatau Stream and continuing along the boundary between Waimarino and Wanganui Acclimatisation Districts to the middle of the Turakina River, thence down the middle of that river to the Wanganui-Hunterville Road, thence along the middle of that road to the middle of the Whangaehu River, thence up the middle of that river to its junction with the Mangawhero River, thence up the middle of that river to its junction with the Rangitatau Stream).

Black swan (only in that portion of the Wellington Acclimatisation District east of the Tararua Ranges)	5 May to 4 June incl.

Duration of 1973 Season

California and brown quail and cock pheasant 5 May to 29 July incl.

Hen pheasant (only in that part of Wellington Acclimatisation District east and south of a line commencing at the start of the divide of the Tararua Range at the Manawatu Gorge on the Society's northern boundary, then along the Tararua Range to the Summit of the Rimutaka Range and thence along the main Featherston-Hutt Road to Mangaroa, thence south along the Hutt River to its confluence with the Whakatiki River, thence west along the Whakatiki River to Wainui Hill (2367'), thence along the Wainui Stream to Paekakariki) 5 May to 29 July incl.

Decoy limit: 25.
