#### Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 8) 1973

PURSUANT to regulation 16 of the Import Control Regulations 1964\*, the Minister of Customs hereby gives notice as follows:

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 8) 1973.

(b) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the New Zealand Gazette.

2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.

3. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of goods of the classes set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, included in the exempting notice shown in the Second Schedule, are hereby withdrawn.

### Customs Act—Dumping Duty

PURSUANT to the provisions of section 129 (1) of the Customs Act 1966, as amended by section 6 of the Customs Amendment Act 1971, notice is hereby given that dumping duty, equivalent to 100 percent of the amount by which the f.o.b. export selling price is less than the current domestic value, determined in accordance with the provisions of this Act, shall be payable in respect of the following goods:
