Varying Determinations by the Minister of Customs under Section 121 of the Customs Act 1966

(i) on and after the 1st day of August 1973, the follow-

ing-Glass, curved or flat Interior trim components of hardboard, cardboard or similar materials Battery cables and earth straps Floor coverings
