

Licensing Taupo County Council to Occupy a Site for a Boat Ramp at Motuoapa, Lake Taupo

PURSUANT to section 162 of the Harbours Act 1950, the Executive Officer, Harbours and Foreshores Section, Ministry of Transport, acting under a delegation from the Minister of Transport pursuant to section 265A of the aforesaid Act, hereby licenses and permits Taupo County Council (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy part of the bed of Lake Taupo at Motuoapa, as shown on plan marked M.D. 14876 and deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining thereon a boat ramp as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

(2) The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of January 1973.

(3) The annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be two dollars (\$2); provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.

Licensing Scott Bros. Ltd. to Occupy a Site for a Pontoon Jetty at Helensville, Kaipara River

Notice to Make Payment of Income Tax Under the Land and Income Tax Act 1954
