

*Approval of Revolving Amber Lights on Traffic Signals
Repair Vehicles*

PURSUANT to regulation 39 of the Traffic Regulations 1956, the Secretary for Transport hereby approves the fitting of one revolving yellow or amber light on any motor vehicle used principally for the installation, maintenance, or repair of electronic traffic signals, subject to the following conditions:

(1) The light shall only be used when it is essential for the vehicle to be parked in a position which obstructs the path of moving traffic.

(2) The light shall not be used while the vehicle is moving.

(3) The vehicle shall be painted a conspicuous colour and shall have the name of the owner or operator clearly painted on the sides and rear.

(4) Suitable and adequate warning signs shall be displayed while the light is being used.

(3) The premium payable by the licensee shall be six dollars (\$6) and the annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be twenty dollars (\$20); provided always that

the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.
