Licensing Winstone Ltd. to Occupy a Site for a Landing Place at Henderson Creek

PURSUANT to section 162 of the Harbours Act 1950, I, Grant Stewart Ellis Milne, of the Ministry of Transport, acting under a delegation authorised by the Minister of Transport pursuant to section 9 of the Ministry of Transport Act 1968, hereby license and permit Winstone Ltd. (1) This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1960 and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

(2) The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of July 1973.

(3) The premium payable by the licensee shall be six dollars (\$6) and the annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be twenty dollars (\$20); provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.
