

## MANAWATU CATCHMENT BOARD

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND FOR THE PURPOSES OF  
SOIL CONSERVATION AND RIVERS CONTROL

IN the matter of the Public Works Act 1928 and its amendments and in the matter of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 and its amendments, notice is hereby given that the Manawatu Catchment Board intends to take, under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1928, the lands situate in and about the bed of the Mangaone Stream and described in the Schedule hereto, for the purposes of soil conservation and river control. A plan of the said lands is deposited at the public office of the Manawatu Catchment Board, 541 Ruahine Street, Palmerston North, and is there open for inspection by all persons at all reasonable hours. All persons affected by the execution of the said public work, or by the taking of the said lands, are hereby required and called upon to set forth, in writing, any objections to the execution of the said public work, or to the taking of the said lands (not being an objection to the amount or payment of compensation), and to send such written objection within 40 days from the first publication of this notice to the Secretary of the Manawatu Catchment Board, 541 Ruahine Street, Palmerston North. If any such objection is made, as aforesaid, a public hearing of the objection will be held, unless the objector otherwise requires, and each objector will be advised of the time and place of the hearing.
